### Welcome, Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance

A regular meeting of the First Tennessee Development District's (FTDD) Board of Directors was held on Wednesday, June 12th at The Bramble in Erwin, Tennessee. Board Chair Mayor Doris Hensley called the meeting to order at 6:34 p.m. and invited Mayor Morrison to deliver the invocation and lead the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

### **Approval of Minutes**

Mayor Hensley requested additions/corrections to the minutes of the September 22<sup>nd</sup> Annual Board of Directors Meeting in Gatlinburg, Tennessee; finding none, she asked for a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Mayor Daniels made the motion, Senator Crowe seconded, and the motion passed without discussion or dissension.

## Presentation of FTDD FY 2019-2020 Work Program and Budget and Consideration of New Positions

FTDD Executive Director Chris Craig presented the Work Program and proposed Budget for the upcoming fiscal year. As the proposed budget included the addition of several new positions to the organization, Mr. Craig also described the need and opportunity to acquire additional staff. Mayor Morrison motioned to accept the Work Program, the budget, and Mr. Craig's recommendation that new positions be added to the FTDD staff; Mayor Clark provided a second and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

#### **Financial Report**

Mayor W.T. Daniels, Board Treasurer, reported that the District was in a favorable financial position and requested the committee's approval of the current financial statement. Mrs. Reid motioned to accept the financial report, Senator Crowe seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

# Presentation of Legislator of the Year Awards

Each year, the Tennessee Development District Association (TDDA) recognizes state legislators that have made significant contributions to their specific development districts by presenting them with "Legislator of the Year" Awards. In 2019, the FTDD selected Senators Rusty Crowe and Jon Lundberg as recipients of the award in recognition of their support of the work of the FTDD by taking legislative action that resulted in life-changing improvements for the people of our region.

Mayor Hensley appointed Washington County Mayor Joe Grandy, Watauga Mayor Delisa LaFleur, Hancock County Mayor Thomas Harrison, and Bluff City Mayor Irene Wells to serve as the nominating committee for 2019; she herself will also serve as an ex-officio member of the committee.

Mr. Craig announced that the FTDD's 2019 Annual Board of Directors Meeting will be held October 25-28 in Gatlinburg.
